EXCHANGE FROM HOME

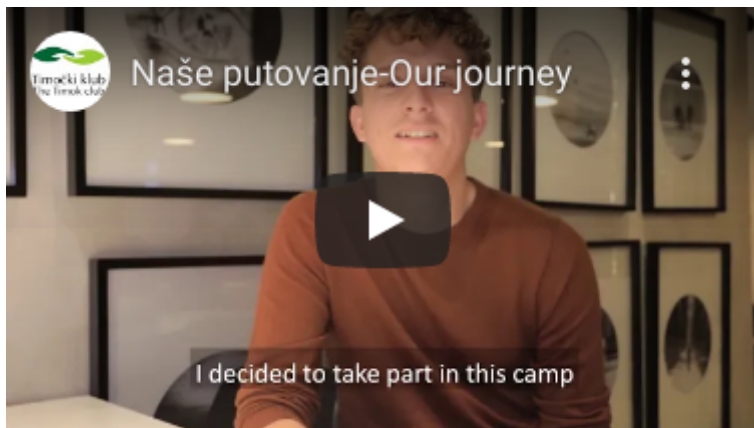
After the end of the Online Summer Camp, the young people were given their homework assignments. They were divided into groups of three members (one member each from Albania, Northern Macedonia and Albania) and worked together online on assigned tasks. Topics covered by the groups were related to cultural heritage, beliefs, history, cinema, tourist attractions, traditional food, music, sports, etc. Each group chose the media and tools through which to present their group work, and in the end we had short joint films, new joint Instagram pages and joint presentations.
